In efforts to capture the time and effort agency employees are contributing towards the COVID 19 Pandemic, the following guidance is provided as tool to assist with **DAILY** reporting as needed.

Reporting time period began March 23, 2020 and will continue until further notice. Agents, Specialists, DAR, CLT, and ELT contributing to COVID 19 efforts should report. Adm. Assistants and support staff may report under the appropriate CLT or ELT groups. County funded support staff should not report. Data is pulled from the Qualtrics database **DAILY** at 5 p.m. for System and State reporting. Please report hours daily prior to 5:00 p.m. Hours not submitted timely, impact this reporting. Do not submit a report if hours did not occur. Retainment of your report is not required unless you wish to do so. Summarized or aggregated reports will not be provided to employees.
