  - a. 52,268 cases reported in Texas, across 225/254 counties; 800,433 tests; 1,440 deaths

- II. DSHS Update [Monty, Joyce]
  - a. Comments about Emergency Department Use: Mental health related events examined by CDC using real-time surveillance found an overall decrease in ED use since beginning of the year for all causes; however, there was an increase in mental health related ED visits (e.g. non-fatal suicide attempts and opioids overdoses).

  - a. NPI Tips of the Week
    - <u>Surfaces</u>: CDC update to SARS-CoV-2 transmission on objects as 'does not spread easily,' but still possible [<u>LINK</u>]
    - Cloth Masks: Cloth masks are largely ineffective in close range (<12 inches or so), especially when coughing or sneezing, while more research is needed for other distances. "That's why public health officials are warning people to remain at least 6 feet apart from one another, even if they are wearing masks. In other words, homemade masks are likely to be just a small piece of the puzzle for controlling the COVID-19 pandemic." [LINK]
    - Gloves: When to wear gloves [CDC LINK]
- V. Evidence-Based Practice Update [Mark]
  - a. Obesity: "...obesity strongly impacts the severity of COVID-19." But, more to learn. [LINK]
  - b. Diabetes: 7,337 COVID-19 patients with or without diabetes was retrospectively studied [LINK]
    - Diabetes status increased the need for medical interventions during COVID-19
    - Diabetes status increased the mortality risk of patients with COVID-19
    - Well-controlled blood glucose correlated with improved outcomes in infected patients
  - c. MMWR Report (May 19, 2020): High COVID-19 Attack Rate Among Attendees at Events at a Church Arkansas, March 2020
    - Primary Cases: 2 symptomatic people (pastor and wife) attended children events at church March 6-8, later tested positive for COVID-19
    - Church Cases: 35/92 attendees acquired COVID-19, 7 hospitalized, 3 deaths
      - Note: Only one case appeared to come from a Bible study occurring at same time
    - Community Cases: With contact tracing, 26 additional cases (1 death) from contact with church cases
    - "...six of the seven hospitalized persons and all three deaths occurred in persons aged ≥65 years, consistent with other <u>U.S. data</u> indicating a higher risk for COVID-19–associated hospitalization and death among persons aged ≥65 years"
      - In Texas, analyzed deaths: 71% are  $\ge 65$  years (40% are  $\ge 80$  years)
